

# LINKING The Duke of Edinburgh's Award into the Curriculum

Students can use the Duke's Award to gain recognition within the NTCE. The Award caters for individual needs and it offers a flexible program which is easy to integrate into the school curriculum.

## NTCE:

Students can gain recognition for completing The Duke of Edinburgh's Award **offline** for Stage 1 units under the SACE 'Community Programs listed for Recognition' as follows:

Bronze Award: 1 x Stage 1 Unit

Silver Award: 2 x Stage 1 Units (if Bronze not done)

Silver Award: 1 x Stage 1 Unit (if Bronze completed)

(All Group 1 only)

The Duke's Award can also be linked **online** into Stage 1 Integrated Studies, Community Studies and Outdoor Education subjects as a Group 1 or Group 2 Unit within the school timetable. The completion of the Bronze Award is a minimum 6 month commitment and the Silver Award is a minimum 12 month commitment. Whilst students may have completed the requirements online for their school subject, they may still have to commit additional extra-curricular hours towards the completion of their Duke of Edinburgh's Award.

No double-dipping! Students cannot complete the Award online and then apply for it to be counted again under the 'Community Programs listed for Recognition' policy.
