



Personal Learning Plan Scholarship for 2017

Application Form

The PLP Scholarship, donated by former teacher Karen Speros, is designed to assist students to continue their education at the College in Year 11. The scholarship provides \$1000 towards tuition costs for one year.

General

1. Entry to the scholarship is open to all Year 10 students that successfully completed PLP with an A Grade.
2. Students must be continuing their education at St Philip's College in Year 11.
3. Students must complete the application form and return it by 8:20 am to Student Access by Monday 28th November. Students on exchange may email me the application. **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
4. Students must be available for an interview on the Wednesday 30th November. Other arrangements will be made for students currently on exchange overseas.
5. If the successful candidate for the PLP Scholarship chooses to not enrol for study at St Philip's College, the scholarship will be revoked.
6. Should a satisfactory standard not be maintained, or an action occur which is deemed to be inappropriate for a student of St Philip's College, then the Career Adviser and the Headmaster, may decided to revoke the scholarship for a particular student.

Interview

1. Students must present themselves at the Career Adviser's office (next to room 63) at the time allocated to them, unless prior arrangements have been made.
2. The interview will be approximately 10 minutes and candidates should be prepared to discuss their future study, training or career plans. Students should bring their resume with them to the interview.
