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Dear Parent/Guardian and Years 9-10 Climbers

As part of the St Philip's College Outdoor Education program and the development of our young climbers, I would like to offer a small group of students the opportunity to participate in a climbing trip with the 2019 Stage 2 Outdoor Education class to Mt Arapiles, Victoria. This trip will be held from Saturday, 25 May to Sunday, 2 June 2019 (Week 6 of Term 2, 2019).

The aim of this trip is to extend our students climbing ability and knowledge in one of the most spectacular climbing environments in Australia. Students will participate in a number of climbs daily with the senior students, who will be getting assessed on this trip. There will be limited spaces available for this trip and students will be expected to be highly motivated and involved in preparation of their own skills beforehand.

PROGRAM

Students will be involved in climbing daily, preparing and cooking meals in small groups, and camping. There will also be some activities unrelated to climbing, such as heading to Horsham (in the possible event of poor climbing weather), and during our overnight stay in Melbourne on the way home.

COSTS

The total cost of the trip will be \$1630.00 all inclusive. The deposit is \$800 and due by Friday, 15 February 2019. The balance of \$830 is due by Friday, 5 April 2019.

All payments are to be made at St Philip's College Reception where payments are fully receipted. Credit card payments are accepted. Cheques should be made out to: St Philip's College.

Students will be required to ensure their medical information is up to date on *MySPC* and consent is given **by Friday, 26 April 2019**. Please complete carefully with as much detail as possible.
